INFORMATION FROM THE BOARD

Previously, it was requested that shareholders complete and return the **Shareholder Official Address and Telephone Form** to the ESC Office by **December 1, 2023**, so if you haven't done so, please do. Besides updating contact information, this form will allow shareholders, if they so desire, to “Opt In” and receive all ESC communication electronically by e-mail. This would include, but not limited to, meeting notices, meeting agendas, written materials, photos, etc. The form can be obtained from the ESC office and the Office Staff or any Board member can assist in the completion.

The electronic voting initiative is in the works. It is still being planned to allow shareholders the options of electronic voting or paper balloting for the Annual Shareholder's Meeting. The Board is encouraging shareholders to participate in the electronic voting process. If you consent to electronic voting, the **Consent to Electronic Voting Form** must be signed and on file with ESC 30 days prior to the annual meeting, scheduled for February 9, 2024, which makes the file date January 10, 2024. If you want to learn more about electronic voting, please visit the website www.hoast-inc.com/videos-and-online-tutorials. The video titled **Voting Just Got Much Easier** will provide you with a 3-minute overview of electronic voting. Joan Roy and the voting committee is spearheading this effort to support the annual meeting. An Electronic Voting Education Forum will be held on January 3, 2024 in the Clubhouse.

If you are planning to run for a Board position, on or before **December 31, 2023**, you must have given WRITTEN notice, either by email attachment, mail, fax, or in person of your desire to run for the Board of Directors. This written notice should be addressed to the Enchanting Shores Co-operative, Inc., 17 Turquoise Ave, Naples, FL. 34114. You may use the **Notice of Intent to be a Candidate for the Board** form for that purpose. You also may submit a **Candidate Information Sheet**, no larger than 8.5 inches by 11 inches, containing your qualifications. This information sheet must be submitted to the Co-operative no later than **January 5th, 2024**. This sheet can be emailed as an email attachment, just not as content in an email message. The **SECOND NOTICE** regarding the Annual Shareholder's Meeting will be sent out no less than 14 days prior to February 9, 2023 meeting date. Like the first notice it will be distributed to shareholders, by their preferred method (in-hand, mail or email). The SECOND NOTICE will include the complete agenda for the Annual Shareholders' Meeting, candidate information sheets, voting materials and any other material pertinent to the agenda. Materials and instructions will also be provided for both paper voting and electronic voting.

The **Maintenance Fee** will remain the same as the 2023 Maintenance Fee. Maintenance Fee coupons were distributed to all shareholders in the December mailing. The first quarterly Maintenance Fee is due January 1, 2024. If you have any questions feel free to contact me.

A HISTORY LESSON*

Following is an article written by a former shareholder and Association Office Manager, Eva Stout. William and Eva Stout resided at 21 Turquoise Avenue from the early days of the Park until they sold their property in November, 2000. Hopefully, from her article, you can get an appreciation for the beginnings of our community. Unfortunately, the history of the Park has not been continued to be chronicled and documented. Perhaps there is a historian in our midst that would have an interest in researching and filling in the gap from where Eva left off to the present day.

Her ending words in this article should be a reminder of the importance of continuing to work together to keep Enchanting Shores the little piece of paradise that it is today.

A PARK IS BORN

Land clearing in 1977-78 by the Henderson Creek Construction Company for what is now a fully developed Mobile Home and RV Park. Enchanting Shores Park covers about 42 acres. The first to be completed was the RV section with Jasper, Pearl, Jade, Onyx, Garnet, Zircon and Bloodstone Drives with a total of 168 sites. In October, 1979 an All-Stream rally was held with about 25 units attending. Also, in October, 1979 the footing for the recreation building was started, and was completed in 1980. This building is a center for meetings, activities, entertainment and classes. It also houses the Park office at 17 Turquoise Avenue, the mailboxes and the laundry facilities.

The Park was officially opened in February 1980 under a rental property concept. Hugh Atkins and George Watkinson were among the first residents to occupy sites. Hugh resided at 20 Peridot Avenue and George lived at 4 Pearl Drive. The first mobile home was erected at 22 Turquoise Avenue in July, 1979 and was occupied by the Park's first managers, Paul and Stella Pfeiffer. Further units continued to be built along Aquamarine Avenue. There are 197 sites in the mobile home section, which includes Aquamarine, Peridot, Amethyst, and Sapphire Avenues. Pool construction started in March, 1981 with completion and opening for swimming on January, 1, 1982. The shuffleboard and tennis courts were also completed in 1981. The second management team, Gamey and Patsy Carter, came aboard in June, 1982. They lived at 22 Turquoise Avenue, and the management and operation of the Park remained in their capable hands until January, 1989.

The Park became a Cooperative in 1988 when residents purchased their lots and became share owners in the Cooperative. There exists a total of 365 lots. Our first Board of Directors were elected, and our Co-op office was in operation with growth and development evident in every area. On January 13, 1989 the Park developer, Enchanting Shores, LTD turned the operation of the Park over to the residents and retained the development of all unsold lots. Our first Board of Directors was elected and our Co-op office was organized and operated by the Association Office Manager, Eva M. Stout. The first year was a time of growth and maturing by a self-maintained Park.

Shareholders elected a second Board of Directors in January, 1990 and a fully operating Cooperative Association Office was turned over to a management team, Gerry and Barbara Gross.

As we continue to grow and thrive, let us all remember those who have worked so diligently to bring Enchanting Shores Park to where it is today.

May we all work together in Peace and Harmony through the coming years.
